Eldecare Enactus Newcastle

Eldecare provides support for older people and alleviates worry for their loved ones, through a device designed to monitor routine and notify their relative or carer of any inconsistencies that could be a potential warning sign of a welfare concern.

Speak Up Enactus Manchester

Speak Up project provides English lessons to migrant parents across Manchester since 2012. Our main aim is to reduce the inequalities faced by migrants with little knowledge of English through our informal and conversational classes. .



Hero's Haven Enactus Cardiff Met

Hero's Haven is a project centered on reaching disadvantaged children through environmental education working with children with specialist learning needs and running outdoor activities such as planting a forest garden.



Toast of the Town Enactus Leicester

Turning surplus bread into beer and using profits to deliver support sessions to aid individuals in their alcohol/substance recovery journey. By partnering with a local organisation and utilising psychology students to deliver these support sessions.



Purifiq Enactus Lancaster

Plastic waste is leading to the degradation of our habitats and oceans. Purifiq is a project developing solutions to improve oral hygiene and combat plastic waste and in turn improve life below ocean and climate action.



PrepMate Enactus Loughborough

PrepMate is a social enterprise with the aim of helping those with an upper limb difference or dexterity impairment to have more confidence in the kitchen through a specially designed chopping board.



Code Pink Enactus Salford

Code Pink reduce the stigma surrounding periods through educating young male learners to increase empathy and understanding about women's issues, providing a more comfortable learning environment for young female learners.







Enactus UK Partnerships

Our partners are critical to the success of the Enactus UK programme - below are some examples of what we have worked on together this year.



Enactus UK Employability Week

In November 2020, over 950+ Enactus UK final year students took part in the Enactus UK Employability week. The students accessed support, guidance and advice designed to accelerate their career journeys after graduation, through 11 sessions run by the Enactus UK partners. Over the course of the year our partners have supported Enactus UK students with 75+ employability sessions which have contributed to the application to hire ratio of Enactus UK students being at 45% success rate.



Enactus UK Coaching Programme

Over the course of year, over 250 business professionals have joined our Enactus UK coaching programme from across all of our partner organisations. With their own experience as a basis, they have provided insight and advice to over 3000+ students whilst developing their own core coaching skills including listening, goal setting and empathising with others. This is critical to the success of our students and teams, as well as being in our opinion a key step between management and leadership.



Diversity and Inclusion Initiatives

Our partners have been integral to furthering our diversity and inclusion mission this year and collaboratively we have held three key events:

- Listening Sessions A discussion with BAME students on accessibility and accommodations to highlight changes that must be made to further the inclusiveness of recruitment processes.
- **Breaking Barriers** An international women's day event with Enterprise Rent-a-Car developed to support over 1000+ female students to break barriers and succeed in their careers.

- Your Voice Matters - A production developed in line with the Black employee network at Amazon to amplify student voice on the topic of belonging in the workplace

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
