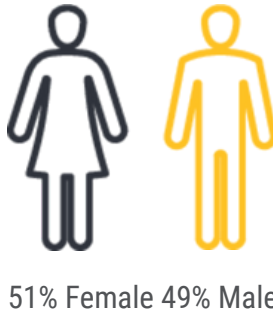
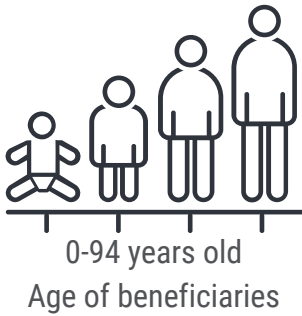

Enactus Sheffield

Motion tackles the rising social issue of sedentary living and social isolation experienced by over 70% of older adults in the UK. Motion is a social enterprise that delivers interactive and inclusive exercise programmes to older adults.

Bee Sustainable is an initiative of Enactus Greenwich. Their goal is to increase bee populations through the development of community gardens and through educational awareness programmes within schools.



GlowCycle

Through the use of varied group and individual activities in creative workshops, GlowCycle aims to help improve the employability and social skills of women previously incarcerated.

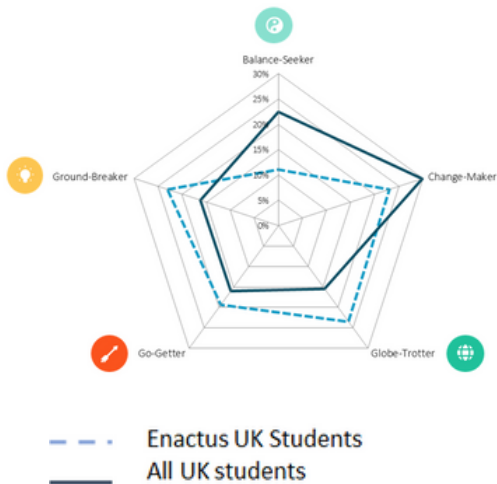

Enactus UK Partnerships

Our partners are critical to the success of the Enactus UK programme. Below are some examples of what we have worked on together this year.



Enactus UK Employability Week

1400+ Enactus UK students took part in the Enactus UK Employability week. The students accessed support, guidance and advice designed to accelerate their career journeys after graduation, through 14 sessions run by the Enactus UK partners. This year, our partners have supported Enactus UK students with 85+ personal and professional development sessions which have contributed to the application to hire ratio of Enactus UK students being at 45% success rate.



Enactus UK Coaching Programme

This past year, over 290+ business professionals have joined our Enactus UK coaching programme. Collectively, the coaches have provided insight and advice to 3500+ students whilst developing their own core coaching skills. A recent Enactus UK coach study showed our coaching programme had a positive impact on the coaches' morale and motivation at work as well as being a positive influence on their personal wellbeing.

Partner Competitions

Thanks to our partners, we have been able to collaboratively develop social impact projects that both benefit the local communities in which they operate and also support the strategic social and environmental sustainability goals of each organisation. Below are just some of the many examples we have developed this year.



Ford - Thanks to the Ford Motor Company Fund teams across the UK received covid support and funding to accelerate their projects within their communities. This was in addition to Ford providing grant funding to our Final Round teams in 2021.

ASDA - 21 new projects were created to meet ASDA's strategy to improve community spaces and places where local people can be together and thrive.

SAP - 15 projects applied for the opportunity to receive mentoring and funding for their projects centred on 'Tech for Good'. The winning project used virtual reality to tackle knife crime within Nottingham.

BIC - With the theme of Using Creativity to create a better more sustainable world, 10 projects received funding to put their ideas into action and create long-lasting social impact with elements of creativity at their core.

Enterprise - Over 30 students took part in monthly challenges based on core competencies that supported their graduate outcomes. Skills developed included communication, work ethic, flexibility and leadership.

Sodexo - Thanks to the Stop Hunger Foundation, 12 teams were able to benefit from funding to support their projects which tackled hunger, supported good nutrition and promoted life skills in local communities.
