WHAT WE DO

Enactus UK supports young people across the country to engage in social action and social enterprise. Our mission in the UK is to be recognised as a leader in developing a national network of socially-minded young leaders of the future, who transform communities and society through real-life social action and environmentally responsible enterprise.

We are dedicated to creating a better world while developing the next generation of entrepreneurial leaders and social innovators. The Enactus network of global business, academic and student leaders is unified by our vision - to create a better, more sustainable world where all can thrive.

Enactus UK catalyses impact for a better, more sustainable world.

As the UK's largest experiential learning programme developing the next generation of responsible leaders, Enactus UK catalyses impact both ON and THROUGH young people in over 60 higher education institutions nationwide.

As a diverse network, we strive to be connected directly with our communities and accelerate the pace of action in the UK around the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.

With the UK only performing well on 17% of the 169 SDG Targets, and with the Dept. of Education no longer providing support on sustainability education at any level, we know that Enactus is needed in the UK now, more than ever:

- 13.4 million people in the UK are currently living in poverty that's one in every five people.
- 9.9 million experienced food poverty in 2022 which has led to the number of emergency food parcels distributed by the Trussell Trust to continually increase, up to 2.1 million in 2021/22.
- Women in deprived areas are 2x as likely to die in pregnancy than those in more affluent areas, with black women 4 1/2x more likely to die.
- The gap in progression rates between those students measured with the Free School Meals indicator (FSM), and non-FSM pupils has increased to 19.1%, its highest level since 2005/2006.

The statistics are a great reminder of why we all must take action locally to address inequality. Enactus UK and our network have remained committed to creating positive change in our communities through entrepreneurial action. This year, our network of youth and business leaders has worked tirelessly to develop sustainable solutions to some of the world's most pressing problems. From empowering marginalised communities to reducing waste and promoting environmental sustainability, Enactus UK teams demonstrated creativity, resilience, and a commitment to making a real difference.

We are proud to have had over 4000 young people participate in our programme this year, with 60 active teams across the country. Our members have invested countless hours developing and executing projects that positively impacted over 15,000 people in the UK.

As we look forward to the future, we remain committed to our mission of creating a better, more sustainable world through entrepreneurial action. We believe that young people have the potential to make a real impact on society, and we will continue to support them every step of the way.

Thank you to all of our changemakers, business partners, university advisors, and supporters for their dedication and support for Enactus UK. Together, we can continue to drive positive change and make a lasting impact in and on our communities.

At Enactus, we create impact **THROUGH** young people by empowering them to become changemakers and leaders in their communities. This year, 4000 young entrepreneurial spirits used our platform to create and develop over **200** social impact and social enterprise projects addressing the most urgent global needs and working towards creating a better more sustainable world for us all.





Enactus Nottingham, **Razoration** By generating revenue through sustainable plastic-free shampoo bars, Razoration supports beneficiaries to enroll on barbering courses with local organisations supporting their journey to self-sufficiency and restoring a sense of purpose and pride. Enactus NTU, **M.O.S.S** Mrs Oakes Sustainable Stories supports quality sustainability education within deprived areas in Nottingham through creative workshops designed to also enhance STEM awareness and interest.





Enactus Durham, **TakaTaka Zero** TakaTaka Zero is a Nairobi-based zero waste food programme and sustainable business, aiming to empower youths, increase food security and clean communities through waste conversion. 200

Spotlight: Sodexo Stop Hunger



Challenge:

Accelerate the Stop Hunger Foundation's mission to alleviate food insecurity and/or empower women throughout the UK

Impact:

Across 3 sessions, 26 Enactus projects worked alongside Sodexo Employees to develop their Stop Hunger ideas. After an in-person pitching opportunity, 5 teams received seed funding and mentoring to address the needs they identified.

Spotlight: BIC UK



Challenge:

Create projects that build the creative skills of children and young people from underserved communities.

Impact:

Through the BIC challenge, 14 teams had the opportunity to use creativity to support the Enactus mission of creating a better more sustainable world.

5 teams were chosen to pitch their ideas with 3 teams receiving seed funding and mentoring to accelerate their impact. BIC leaders will continue to coach, mentor and engage with the winning teams across the next year to support in project development and success. From this specific opportunity, we expect over **5000** young people to be directly impacted as a result of BIC's support.

Measuring Success - Business Collaboration

We know that business collaboration delivers a positive impact on business, young people, and the world. We are proud to work with **300+** mentors, volunteers, and coaches who collaborate with Enactus UK to create impact both <u>ON</u> and <u>THROUGH</u> young people. This accelerates our joint impact on the SDG's through longer-term meaningful engagement opportunities whilst simultaneously providing a professional development opportunity for the coach.



Our experiential coach programme supercharges participants' professional development through immersive application, skills-based engagement, social learning, and network building.



Coaches are paired with University teams strategically. This could be based on **skills required, region** or in line with **talent acquistion, ED&I** and **social mobility** strategies.



Coaches meet with their teams regularly to discuss project and team development. Coaches **practise** their coaching whilst **shaping** ideas and approach to **catalyse** impact.



Coaches are recognised for their contribution each year at our Enactus UK National Expo with specific **awards** and an **Enactus UK Coaching Certification.**
